



Van Wert City Schools Remote Learning Plan

INTRODUCTION: The purpose of this document is to share the district's remote learning plan with parents and students. Remote learning has two different components: Parent-Selected Remote Learning or District Determined Remote Learning. These plans are fluid and may change as more guidelines are released.

Remote learning selected by the parent is called **Parent-Selected Remote Learning**. Each building will have a specific plan for parent-selected remote learning. In the event that District Determined Remote Learning takes place, these students may remain on the parent-selected remote learning plan depending on the situation.

Remote learning that is determined by the superintendent or the state level will be called **District Determined Remote Learning**. This will be when all students are learning from home using the Zoom platform and Google Classroom or ECHO, and the daily school schedule will be adjusted to a nontraditional schedule to accommodate remote learning.

Parent-Selected Remote Learning

Each building will have unique remote learning expectations. To learn these expectations, families are asked to contact the building principal. The deadline to commit to Parent Selected Remote Learning is Friday August 7, 2020.

Attendance

Student attendance will be tracked based on ODE expectations.

Related Services

Each student who is provided with related services such as Speech, OT, and PT under his/her IEP/504 Plans will receive these services through remote learning. These sessions will be scheduled through the school provider.





District Determined Remote Learning

Communication

Teachers will post assignments and communications via Google Classroom or ECHO. Emails may be used as reminders that direct students to the content/instruction posted on Google Classroom or ECHO; however, email communication will not be used to give new material and instruction not posted. Teachers will communicate with parents primarily via email, but may also do so via Zoom and phone/text messaging.

Time

Teachers have been instructed by building principals that they may not be accessible at all hours of the day/night for student assistance. Students requiring extra help should seek assistance from the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Attendance

Students are expected to be in attendance. If a student is unable to attend school (Zoom session) because of technical issues/family issues and or illness, a parent is required to follow normal attendance policy and contact the school. Additionally, attendance will also be monitored through Van Wert City School's Student Information System (SIS/DASL).

Instruction

Teachers will conduct live Zoom sessions or pre-recorded videos based on the schedule below. The instructional content will be based on essential state standards. Posts from teachers will contain all informational and student resource items associated with the lesson. Teachers may also use other technology-based platforms such as EdPuzzle, Flip Grid, Google Docs/Forms/Slides/Sheets, to name a few. These will all be integrated within Google Classroom or ECHO for student access. Students are expected to attend Zoom sessions. Teachers should communicate clear expectations and guidelines while also remaining flexible due to the nature of a remote learning environment.

Zoom

All Zoom sessions will be recorded and posted by teachers. Students who miss must complete all work according to the teacher's classroom policy. Missing excessive zoom sessions will be handled in the same manner as the school attendance policy stated in the handbook.





IEP/504

Students who are on IEPs and 504 Plans will have scheduled meeting times (in person or virtually) with their intervention teacher(s). Students are required to attend those sessions. These meetings will be scheduled either as a small group or individually by the intervention teacher. Students will have access to Intervention teachers during the core instruction period. Due to the unconventional nature of remote learning, students may need additional modifications and accommodations to assessments/daily work.

Related Services

Each student who is provided with related services such as Speech, OT, and PT under his/her IEP/504 Plan will receive these services through remote learning. These sessions will be scheduled through the school provider.

Student Assessment

Grades will be taken during remote learning. Students will be assessed via assignments, projects, and quizzes/tests.

Grading/Promotion

The grading scale for individual grade levels is provided in the respective student handbooks. Promotion and retention policies will be applied.

Student Progress

In grades 4-12, student progress will be monitored via ECHO or ProgressBook grading suite. Parents and students have access to this platform and can check it daily. Parents of students in grades Pre-K through 8 will receive a grade card at the end of each trimester (approximately 60 days). Progress Reports are provided for grades 1-8 at the midpoint in a trimester (approximately 30 days). In grades 9-12, grade cards will be issued at the end of the quarter. Interim reports will be issued to parents at the midpoint of the grading period.
